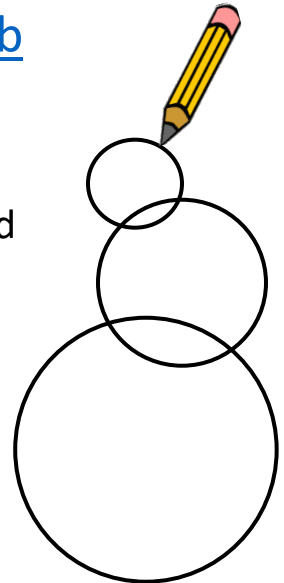

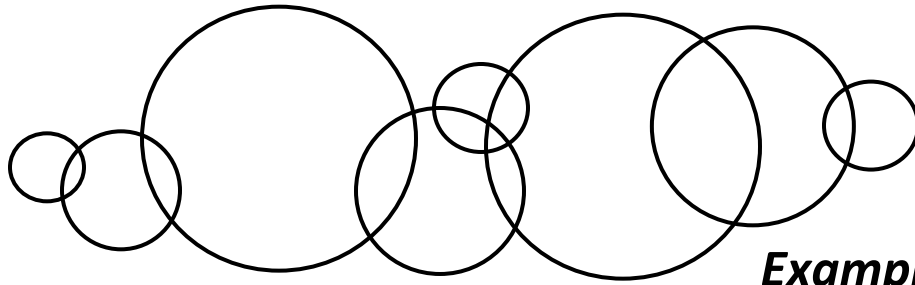

Art Project Instructions:

1. First, go on a *scavenger hunt* around your house! Find things that are **circular** and can be used to trace the outline of a circle. You will use these things to create art by tracing the outlines of circles of different sizes. Big circles and small ones! See how many you can find! Try to find at least 6 - 10 different circles.
2. Next, find some **paper** and any **art tools** you have at home (*pencil, pen, marker, colored pencil*) to trace your circles. Let them **overlap** and **go off the edge of the page** to make your drawing interesting!
3. Last, fill in each area of the page with a different **color** to make a beautiful, colorful work of art!
